## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act providing for the Restoration of James J. Mahar to his Standing as an Original Member of the Boston Retirement System.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 James J. Mahar, formerly schoolhouse commis-  
2 sioner of the city of Boston and now employed  
3 by said city as domestic engineer under its school  
4 committee, shall, upon repayment to the Boston  
5 retirement system of the accumulated deductions  
6 withdrawn by him, have all the benefits of the  
7 Boston retirement act to which he would have  
8 been entitled had he continued to be an employee  
9 of said city without interruption from the time  
10 of the establishment of said system.
