

To accompany the petition of Edward J. Cox that the salary of the assistant clerk of the legislative document room be established. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act establishing the Salary of the Assistant Clerk of the Legislative Document Room.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section eighteen of chapter three
2 of the General Laws, as amended by section one
3 of chapter three hundred and sixty-seven of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, by
5 section one of chapter three hundred and sixty-
6 six of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
7 two, by section one of chapter four hundred of
8 the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-three,
9 and by section one of chapter four hundred and
10 one of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
11 four, is hereby further amended by striking out,
12 in the twelfth line, the word "seventeen" and
13 inserting in place thereof the word: — twenty-
14 two, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 18.*
15 There shall be a doorkeeper for each branch, each
16 at a salary of twenty-three hundred dollars, and
17 such assistant doorkeepers as it may direct, each

18 at a salary of nineteen hundred dollars; a post-
19 master at a salary of twenty-three hundred dol-
20 lars; an assistant postmaster; messengers, each
21 at a salary of seventeen hundred dollars; pages
22 whose compensation shall be six hundred and
23 fifty dollars each for the regular annual session
24 and a sum not exceeding three dollars for each
25 day's service after said session; a clerk to take
26 charge of the legislative document room at a
27 salary of twenty-three hundred dollars, an assist-
28 ant clerk of said room at a salary of twenty-two
29 hundred dollars, and such assistants therein as
30 may be necessary, for whose fitness and good
31 conduct the sergeant-at-arms shall be responsible.

1 SECTION 2. The increase in salary provided
2 for by this act shall not take effect until an ap-
3 propriation has been made sufficient to cover the
4 same and then as of June first in the current year.
