

To accompany the petition of Mary A. Sullivan and others that provision be made for the appointment of matrons in the police department of the city of Worcester. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act providing for the Appointment of Matrons in the Police Department of the City of Worcester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor of the city of Worces-
2 ter is hereby authorized to appoint without
3 further civil service examination the police ma-
4 trons now employed as such by said city, and
5 having been so employed since nineteen hundred
6 and eighteen, as regular members of the police
7 department.

1 SECTION 2. Any matron appointed under sec-
2 tion one hereof shall be entitled to pension as
3 provided by chapter thirty-two of the General
4 Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of the city
3 of Worcester; provided that such acceptance
4 occurs during the current year.
