## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act to authorize the School Committee of the City of Boston to establish and maintain a Junior College of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The school committee of the city of Boston  
2 shall have authority to establish and maintain a  
3 junior college of the city of Boston, and to pro-  
4 vide therein such courses of instruction as the  
5 board of superintendents may prescribe for the  
6 preparation of persons for higher institutions of  
7 learning or for commercial, industrial, and other  
8 vocations.
