

SENATE No. 231

To accompany the petition of E. G. Pond that the taking of deer in the county of Norfolk be prohibited until the year nineteen hundred and twenty-eight. Conservation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act prohibiting until the Year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-eight the Taking of Deer in the County of Norfolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whoever, except as otherwise provided in
2 section sixty-two, eighty-two or eighty-three of
3 chapter one hundred and thirty-one of the
4 General Laws, before the beginning of the open
5 season on deer throughout the commonwealth
6 in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-eight,
7 hunts, pursues, wounds or kills a deer in Norfolk
8 county, or sells or offers for sale, or has in pos-
9 session, a deer or any part thereof, captured or
10 killed in said county, shall be punished by a fine
11 of one hundred dollars.
