## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Seven.

An Act providing for the Reimbursement of the Commonwealth for Certain Blanks and Papers Furnished Savings and Insurance Banks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and seventy-eight of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out  
3 section seventeen and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following:— *Section 17.* No charge shall be  
5 made to the banks by the General Insurance  
6 Guaranty Fund or by the commonwealth for the  
7 services rendered by the state actuary or the state  
8 medical director. The amount expended by the  
9 commonwealth during each year ending Novem-  
10 ber thirtieth for the blanks and books furnished  
11 to the savings and insurance banks under section  
12 fifteen shall be apportioned by the trustees of  
13 the General Insurance Guaranty Fund among  
14 the said banks in proportion to their premium  
15 income or on such other basis as the said trustees  
16 shall deem equitable and proper, and said banks  
17 shall be assessed therefor in accordance with such

18 apportionment. The amounts so assessed shall  
19 be paid into the state treasury by said banks not  
20 later than the fifteenth of December next suc-  
21 ceeding.
