An Act relative to the Use of the Water of Farm Pond in the Town of Sherborn by the Medfield State Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subject to the approval of the
2 department of public health and to such con-
3 ditions and restrictions as it may prescribe, the
4 trustees of the Medfield state hospital may, for
5 the purpose of securing an adequate water supply
6 for said hospital as authorized by chapter two
7 hundred and fifty-one of the acts of eighteen
8 hundred and ninety-seven, take water from
9 Farm Pond in the town of Sherborn, notwith-
10 standing the restrictions imposed on such taking
11 by chapter four hundred and sixty-six of the
12 acts of nineteen hundred and eight or by any
13 other provision of law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not be operative
2 on and after May first, nineteen hundred and
3 twenty-eight. _____
