By Mr. Green of Cambridge, petition of the mayor and city council that the city of Cambridge be authorized to pension John Mehigan who has been employed in the street department of said city. Pensions. Dec. 17, 1927.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the City of Cambridge to pension
John Mehigan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Cambridge is hereby au-
2 thorized to pay to John Mehigan, a former member
3 of the street department, an annual pension of seven
4 hundred and eighty dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by vote of the city council of said city sub-
3 ject to the provisions of its charter, provided that such
4 acceptance occurs prior to December thirty-first in
5 the current year.
