

By Mr. Osborne of Lynn, petition of Frank W. Osborne for an extension of the time during which the cities of Lynn, Peabody, Salem and Beverly and the town of Danvers may take water from the Ipswich River for emergency purposes. Water Supply. Dec. 19, 1927.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act extending the Time during which the Cities of Lynn, Peabody, Salem and Beverly and the Town of Danvers may take Water from the Ipswich River for Emergency Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred
2 and fifteen of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred
3 and nineteen, as amended by section one of chapter
4 sixty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
5 two, and by section one of chapter nineteen of the acts
6 of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby further
7 amended by striking out, in the tenth, eleventh and
8 twelfth lines, the words "nineteen hundred and
9 twenty-five, nineteen hundred and twenty-six and
10 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven" and inserting in
11 place thereof the words:— nineteen hundred and
12 twenty-eight, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and
13 nineteen hundred and thirty,— so as to read as
14 follows:— *Section 1.* The cities of Lynn, Peabody,
15 Salem and Beverly and the town of Danvers, au-

16 thorized to take water from the Ipswich river or its
17 tributaries during the months from December to
18 May, inclusive, under the provisions of chapter five
19 hundred and eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and
20 one and chapters six hundred and ninety-eight, six
21 hundred and ninety-nine and seven hundred of the
22 acts of nineteen hundred and thirteen, are hereby
23 further authorized, in case of emergency, to take water
24 from said river or its tributaries during the months
25 from June to November, inclusive, in the years nine-
26 teen hundred and twenty-eight, nineteen hundred and
27 twenty-nine and nineteen hundred and thirty, or
28 any of said years, in quantities not exceeding those
29 which may be taken from December to May, inclu-
30 sive, as set forth in said acts, whenever, in the opinion
31 of the department of public health, the taking of
32 water during the months aforesaid in the years men-
33 tioned, or any of them, is necessary to provide an
34 adequate water supply for the cities and town herein
35 mentioned, subject otherwise to the remaining pro-
36 visions of said acts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
