**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

---

An Act to authorize the City of Northampton to accept a Gift of Certain Real Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Northampton is hereby  
2 authorized and empowered to take and hold the real  
3 estate in said city conveyed to it by Fannie B. Look  
4 by her deed of gift dated April twenty, nineteen  
5 hundred and twenty-seven, and known as the  
6 "Frank Newhall Look Memorial Park", according  
7 to the purposes and subject to the conditions set  
8 forth in said deed of gift, and the vote of the city  
9 council in said city on June two, nineteen hun-  
10 dred and twenty-seven, accepting said gift is hereby  
11 ratified and confirmed and said city of Northampton  
12 may appropriate and pay annually to the trustees of  
13 the "Frank Newhall Look Memorial Park" the sum  
14 of four thousand dollars for the maintenance and  
15 upkeep of said park.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
