The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to the Protection of Foxes in Barnstable County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fifty-one of chapter one hundred and
2 thirty-one of the General Laws, as amended by
3 chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and twenty-one and by chapter
5 one hundred and four and section two of chapter
6 three hundred and twenty, both of the acts of nine-
7 teen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby further
8 amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-
9 ing new sentence:— Between March first and
10 October thirty-first in any year no person shall take
11 or kill a fox in Barnstable county or have in posses-
12 sion a fox taken in said county.
