

By Mr. Twohig of Boston, petition of the Massachusetts State Branch, American Federation of Labor, for an amendment of the law relative to minimum retirement allowances for members of the retirement system of the city of Boston. Pensions. Jan. 10.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act amending an Act relative to Minimum Retirement Allowances for Members of the Boston Retirement System retired for Superannuation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section ten of chapter five hundred and twenty-
2 one of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
3 two, as amended by section one of chapter four
4 hundred and twenty-six of the acts of nineteen hun-
5 dred and twenty-three and by section three of
6 chapter two hundred and fifty-two of the acts of
7 nineteen hundred and twenty-four, is hereby further
8 amended by striking out paragraph (d) and insert-
9 ing in place thereof the following:—

10 (d) If the retirement allowance provided under
11 the foregoing clauses of this section for a member
12 who has been an employee for fifteen years or more
13 would otherwise be less than half-pay a year, an
14 additional pension sufficient to make a total re-
15 tirement allowance of half-pay a year.
