Under the provisions of section 7 of chapter 3 of the General Laws, there is submitted herewith petition of the Arlington Baptist Society to hold additional real and personal estate.

This society was incorporated by a special act, chapter 105 of the Special Acts of 1816. By section 2 of said chapter it was limited in its holding to the sum of \$30,000. The present petition requests that all limitation as to its holdings be stricken out.

This would require special legislation.

No fee is required.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the Arlington Baptist Society to hold  
Additional Real and Personal Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section two of an act entitled "An Act to incorpo-  
2 rate the West-Cambridge Baptist Society", approved  
3 by the governor on December fourteenth, eighteen hun-  
4 dred and sixteen, as affected by chapter two hundred  
5 and twenty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and  
6 sixty-seven, is hereby amended by striking out all after  
7 the word "Society" in the fifth line, — so as to read  
8 as follows:— *Section 2. Be it further enacted*, That said  
9 society, so incorporated, shall have power to receive, by  
10 donation or otherwise, and to purchase, hold and enjoy  
11 such real and personal estate, as they may deem neces-  
12 sary for the due support of religious worship in said  
13 society.
