An Act governing Exemptions of State Employees
from Civil Service Regulations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-two of chapter one hundred and
2 twenty-three of the General Laws is hereby
3 amended by striking out the words "engineers, fire-
4 men and", so that said section shall read as follows:
5 — *Section 42.* Head farmers employed in state
6 hospitals shall be exempt from chapter thirty-one.
