The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act to authorize and empower the Register of Probate and Insolvency for the County of Suffolk to Deliver to the Secretary of the Commonwealth all Insolvency Files in his Custody and to make said Secretary the Legal Custodian thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The register of probate and insol-
2 vency for the county of Suffolk is hereby authorized
3 and empowered to deliver to the secretary of state
4 all insolvency files now or hereafter in the custody
5 of said register, provided, that the indices and the
6 dockets of the court of insolvency for said county
7 shall remain in the custody of said register. The
8 secretary of state shall thereafter be the legal cus-
9 todian of said files and shall keep them in accord-
10 ance with the provisions of law relating thereto.

1 SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed in so far as they relate
3 hereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
