An Act prohibiting the Setting of Trawls in Certain Waters during the Months of March, April and May in any Year.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whoever sets any trawls from March first to
2 May thirty-first, both dates inclusive, in any year
3 in the waters lying northerly and easterly by a line
4 drawn from Angelica Point in the town of
5 to the entrance of West Falmouth harbor, shall be
6 punished by a fine of .
