## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to the School Committee of the City of Revere.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section forty-seven of chapter six hundred and  
2 eighty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 fourteen, is hereby amended by striking out in said  
4 section the following "the president of the council  
5 shall preside at such meetings, and the vacancy  
6 shall be filled from the ward in which the vacancy  
7 occurs by a vote of a majority of all the members  
8 of the two bodies. The term of the person thus  
9 chosen shall terminate with the end of the cur-  
10 rent municipal year; and inserting in place thereof  
11 the following:— The president of the council shall  
12 preside at such meeting and the vacancy shall be  
13 filled by vote of a majority of all the members of  
14 the two bodies. The term of the person thus chosen  
15 shall continue until his successor is duly elected and  
16 qualified at the next municipal election,— so as to  
17 read as follows:— *Section 47.* Whenever a

18 vacancy shall occur in the membership of the school  
19 committee, the mayor shall call a joint meeting of  
20 the council and the school committee. The president  
21 of the council shall preside at such meeting and the  
22 vacancy shall be filled by vote of a majority of all  
23 the members of the two bodies. The term of the  
24 person thus chosen shall continue until his succes-  
25 sor is duly elected and qualified at the next municipi-  
26 pal election.
