In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act Prohibiting Soliciting or Rides or Unauthorized Riding in or on Motor Vehicles

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter section is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following:—  
3 It shall be unlawful for persons unknown to the  
4 driver of a motor vehicle to by voice or hand solicit  
5 a ride on motor vehicles, except that this shall not  
6 be construed as referring to the signalling to the  
7 drivers of motor vehicles carrying passengers for  
8 hire. It shall be unlawful for a person or persons  
9 to board, or attempt to board, a motor vehicle with-  
10 out the express consent of the operator. Persons  
11 so doing will in case of accident not be entitled to  
12 any recourse at law to recover for any injuries sus-  
13 tained. Persons violating the provisions of this  
14 section shall be liable to a fine of not less than ten  
15 nor more than twenty-five dollars.
