

By Mr. Birmingham of Boston, petition of Leo M. Birmingham for an amendment of the law relative to the suspension or revocation by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of licenses of operators of motor vehicles. Highways and Motor Vehicles. Jan. 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to the Revocation, Suspension and Restoration of Certain Operators' Licenses under the Motor Vehicle Law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-two of chapter ninety of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as amended by section six of chapter
3 four hundred and sixty-four of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and twenty-three, is hereby further
5 amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-
6 ing:—except that the registrar shall not suspend
7 or revoke the license of any operator for the com-
8 mission of any offence for which said operator has
9 been tried in any court of this commonwealth and
10 found not guilty, and if the license of any operator
11 has been suspended for an offence for the commis-
12 sion of which he is later found not guilty in any
13 court of this commonwealth, then the registrar shall
14 immediately on such finding of not guilty restore
15 said license.
