An Act authorizing the Refusal by a Citizen to Aid an Officer by the use of Property in Certain Cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-four of chapter two hundred and
2 sixty-eight of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by adding at the end the following sentence:—
4 This section shall not be deemed to prohibit or
5 penalize such neglect or refusal to assist by the use
6 of property.
