The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act to authorize the New England Deaconess Association to hold Additional Property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. New England Deaconess Association,
2 incorporated under the General Laws of the common-
3 wealth of Massachusetts in eighteen hundred and eighty-
4 nine as New England Deaconess Home and Training
5 School, and whose powers were extended by chapter
6 two hundred and four of the acts of eighteen hundred
7 and ninety-three, and its name changed to New England
8 Deaconess Association by chapter two hundred and
9 twenty of the acts of nineteen hundred and one, may
10 take and hold real and personal property to an amount
11 not exceeding five million dollars, anything in the charter
12 of the said association or in any law of the common-
13 wealth to the contrary notwithstanding.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
