**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the Discontinuance of the Draw in the Dover Street Bridge over Fort Point Channel in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter seventy-one of  
2 the acts of June, eighteen hundred and thirty-one,  
3 is hereby amended so as to read that the draw on  
4 Boston south bridge as defined in said act, now  
5 called Dover street bridge for the accommodation of  
6 vessels which have occasion to pass the same by  
7 night or day be discontinued.

1 SECTION 2. The city of Boston is authorized to  
2 build a new public highway to take the place of the  
3 present Dover street bridge, so-called, over Fort  
4 Point channel.

1 SECTION 3. Any person sustaining damages by  
2 reason of property or rights in property taken or  
3 injured by the city of Boston under authority of  
4 this act shall be entitled to recover same under  
5 chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws.
