In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the County of Dukes County to acquire Land at South Beach in that Part of the Town of Edgartown known as Katama.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For park purposes, the county commissioners
2 of the county of Dukes County may take by eminent
3 domain under chapter seventy-nine of the General
4 Laws or acquire by purchase, certain land at South
5 Beach in that part of the town of Edgartown known
6 as Katama, being Lot "A" as shown on a plan
7 drawn by William S. Swift & Sons, Surveyors,
8 dated July twenty-third, nineteen hundred and
9 twenty-seven and filed in the land registration
10 office at Boston, Massachusetts, a copy of a portion
11 of which, numbered 10343-B, is filed with Certificate
12 of Title, Number 322, in the registry district of
13 Dukes County, and bounded northerly by Lot "B"
14 as shown on plan above mentioned, nine hundred
15 and sixty-four and eighty-five one hundredths feet,
16 easterly by land of owners unknown measuring on
17 the upland about ninety-eight feet, southerly by the
18 Atlantic ocean and southwesterly by a town road
19 measuring on the upland about one hundred and
20 sixty feet.

21 For the purpose of acquiring such land as afore-
22 said, there is hereby appropriated, and said county
23 commissioners are hereby authorized to levy as a
24 part of the county tax of said county for the current
25 year, such sum as may be necessary therefor, not
26 exceeding fifteen hundred dollars.
