## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to Expenditures by the Town of Wakefield for Municipal Advertising Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Wakefield may annually  
2 appropriate a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars  
3 for the purpose of advertising the advantages of the  
4 town with special reference to its facilities for indus-  
5 trial and residential purposes; provided, however,  
6 that as to each such appropriation a sum equal to the  
7 amount thereof shall previously have been raised by  
8 public subscription and paid into the town treasury  
9 to be expended for the aforesaid advertising purpose.  
10 The money so appropriated by the town and so raised  
11 by subscription shall be expended under the direction  
12 of the board of selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance by a majority of the voters of the town of  
3 Wakefield present and voting thereon at any special  
4 or regular town meeting; and for the purpose only of  
5 being submitted to the voters of said town as afore-  
6 said this act shall take effect upon its passage.
