## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

---

An Act authorizing the Erection and Maintenance by the Boston Elevated Railway Company of a Shelter on Land in the Town of Watertown deeded to said Town by the Commonwealth for Park or Street Widening Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. If and as authorized by the selectmen  
2 of the town of Watertown, with the approval of the  
3 metropolitan district commission, the Boston Ele-  
4 vated Railway Company may erect and maintain a  
5 shelter for the accommodation of street railway  
6 passengers on land in Watertown on Mount Auburn  
7 street extension, so-called, said land having been  
8 deeded to said town of Watertown by the metropoli-  
9 tan district commission under the provisions of chap-  
10 ter four hundred and seventy-five of the acts of nine-  
11 teen hundred and twelve, as from time to time  
12 extended. Authority is hereby given to said selectmen  
13 to grant such authorization and to said commission  
14 to signify such approval.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
