In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

---

An Act relative to Appropriations by the City of Boston  
for Municipal Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may by vote of  
2 the city council, with the approval of the mayor, in  
3 the manner specified in section three of chapter four  
4 hundred and eighty-six of the acts of nineteen hun-  
5 dred and nine, make appropriations for municipal  
6 purposes to be raised by taxation for the financial  
7 year ending December thirty-first, nineteen hundred  
8 and twenty-eight, not exceeding the sum of twelve  
9 dollars and fifty cents on each one thousand dollars  
10 of the valuation upon which the appropriations by  
11 the city council are based.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
