An Act relative to the Payment of Salaries of Teachers and Supervisors employed in Schools within the Department of Education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section thirty-one of chapter twenty-
2 nine of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
3 at the end thereof the following: — Notwithstanding
4 the foregoing provisions of this section, the annual
5 salary of each teacher and each supervisor employed
6 in any school within the department of education,
7 whose regular service is rendered from September
8 first to June thirtieth, shall be for his service for the
9 number of weeks established by the department for
10 such school to be in session during said period, payable,
11 however, in equal instalments on the first day of each
12 month, and the amount earned and unpaid at the
13 time of his resignation, retirement, death or entry on
14 leave of absence shall be paid forthwith to the persons
15 entitled thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the salary of
2 every teacher or supervisor as aforesaid who resigned,
3 retired, died or entered on leave of absence after Feb-
4 ruary first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.
