## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act to establish a Portion of the Town Line between  
the Towns of Marshfield and Scituate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The following described line shall  
2 hereafter constitute a portion of the boundary line  
3 between the towns of Marshfield and Scituate; be-  
4 ginning at an unmarked point in the main channel  
5 of North river, said point bearing westerly from  
6 Fourth Cliff in the town of Scituate; thence following  
7 the main channel of South river (the greater part of  
8 which, previous to the storm of eighteen hundred  
9 and ninety-eight, was North river) in a southerly  
10 direction to an unmarked point in the channel of  
11 South river; thence north sixty degrees fifty-two  
12 minutes fifty-two and fifty-eight one hundredths  
13 seconds east (true bearing) to a stone monument near  
14 the westerly shore of Humarock beach in latitude  
15 forty-two degrees seven minutes thirty-one and sixty-  
16 four one hundredths seconds, longitude seventy de-  
17 grees forty minutes fifty-eight and eight hundred

18 seventy-eight one thousandths seconds; thence same  
19 bearing four hundred forty seven and eighteen one  
20 hundredths feet to a memorial tablet near highwater  
21 mark, on the easterly side of said Humarock beach;  
22 thence by same bearing to the exterior line of the  
23 commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
