An Act relative to the Establishment of Public Play-
grounds by Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fourteen of chapter forty-five of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following:—The provisions of
4 section fifteen or sixteen shall not be construed to
5 apply to any city or town because of any action
6 taken under this section.
