Resolve providing for the Construction by the Commonwealth of a Fitting Memorial to the Late Henry Cabot Lodge.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor and council are hereby
2 authorized to cause to be laid out and constructed on
3 the state house grounds a suitable memorial to com-
4 memorate the services to the commonwealth of Henry
5 Cabot Lodge, a former member of the general court of
6 Massachusetts and for thirty-seven years a member of
7 the congress of the United States from this common-
8 wealth. Said memorial shall be paid for out of such
9 sum, not exceeding thirty thousand dollars, as may be
10 appropriated by the general court, all expenditures
11 to be approved by the governor and council.
