An Act establishing the Salary of the Third Assistant  
District Attorney for the Eastern District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section sixteen of chapter twelve of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by section two of chapter three  
3 hundred and four of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
4 twenty-two, by section two of chapter two hundred  
5 and eleven and by section two of chapter three hun-  
6 dred and ninety-eight, both of the acts of nineteen  
7 hundred and twenty-three, by section two of chapter  
8 two hundred and sixty-five of the acts of nineteen  
9 hundred and twenty-four, by section two of chapter  
10 two hundred and eighty-five and by chapter three  
11 hundred and thirty-seven, both of the acts of nine-  
12 teen hundred and twenty-five, and by section one of  
13 chapter three hundred and seventy-seven and by sec-  
14 tion two of chapter three hundred and eighty-four,  
15 both of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-six,  
16 and by section one of chapter three hundred and five  
17 of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, is  
18 hereby further amended by striking out, in the thir-  
19 teenth line, as appearing in said chapter three hundred  
20 and seventy-seven, the word "eighteen" and inserting  
21 in place thereof the word: — twenty-four, — so as to

22 read as follows: — *Section 16.* Assistant, second assist-  
23 ant and third assistant district attorneys and deputy  
24 district attorneys shall receive from the common-  
25 wealth salaries as follows:

26 For the Suffolk district, two assistants, sixty-five  
27 hundred dollars; four assistants, five thousand dollars;  
28 two assistants, four thousand dollars; and two assist-  
29 ants, three thousand dollars.

30 For the northern district, assistant, five thousand  
31 dollars; second assistants, four thousand dollars.

32 For the eastern district, assistant, thirty-six hun-  
33 dred dollars; second assistant, three thousand dollars;  
34 third assistant, twenty-four hundred dollars.

35 For the middle district, assistant, thirty-six hundred  
36 dollars; second assistant, three thousand dollars;  
37 third assistant, twenty-four hundred dollars.

38 For the southeastern district, assistant, thirty-six  
39 hundred dollars; second assistant, three thousand dol-  
40 lars; deputy district attorney, such compensation as  
41 shall be fixed by the district attorney, with the ap-  
42 proval of the chief justice of the superior court.

43 For the southern district, assistant, three thousand  
44 dollars; second assistant, twenty-four hundred dollars.

45 For the western district, assistant, twenty-four  
46 hundred dollars; second assistant, two thousand  
47 dollars.
