## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the Governor to apply for and receive Certain Federal Funds Equitably Belonging to Battery A, One Hundred and Second Regiment, Field Artillery, Veterans' Association of Haverhill.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The governor is hereby authorized to apply to the
- 2 finance officer of the war department of the United
- 3 States at Washington, D. C., for the payment to him
- 4 of certain funds held by said finance officer which
- 5 equitably belong to battery A, one hundred and
- 6 second regiment, field artillery, veterans' association
- 7 of Haverhill, and the governor is further authorized to
- 8 receive said funds and pay them over to said asso-
- 9 ciation.
