An Act increasing the Compensation of Court Officers in the Municipal Court of the City of Boston for Criminal Business.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section seventy-five of chapter two
- 2 hundred and eighteen of the General Laws, as amended
- 3 by section two of chapter two hundred and eighty-four
- 4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, by
- 5 section two of chapter three hundred and nine of the
- 6 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, by section
- 7 two of chapter three hundred and twenty-three and
- 8 section two of chapter four hundred and forty-eight,
- 9 both of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
- 10 three, and by section one of chapter five hundred and
- 11 six of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-four,
- 12 is hereby further amended by striking out the last
- 13 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the follow-
- 14 ing: -
- 15 The salary of the chief court officer and of the
- 16 assistant chief court officer of the municipal court of
- 17 the city of Boston for criminal business shall be three
- 18 thousand dollars and twenty-seven hundred and
- 19 eighty-four dollars, respectively, the salary of each of
- 20 the other court officers in attendance at the criminal
- 21 sessions of said court, twenty-six hundred and eighty-

- 22 four dollars, and the salary of each of the court officers
- 23 in attendance at the civil sessions of said court,
- 24 twenty-four hundred and eighty-four dollars.
 - 1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its
- 2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city,
- 3 subject to the provisions of its charter; provided,
- 4 that such acceptance occurs during the current year.
