The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to Exchange Land with the Commonwealth for Purposes of the Marine Park in Said City.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Boston, by vote of its city council
2 approved by its mayor, is hereby authorized in con-
3 sideration of the conveyance to it for park purposes
4 of land at least equal in area, to convey to the com-
5 monwealth of Massachusetts by deed approved by
6 the attorney general all the rights, title and interest
7 of said city in and to certain land and flats at South
8 Boston, being a part of an area now known as Marine
9 park, lying easterly of Farragut road and between
10 said road and the flats of the commonwealth, and
11 acquired by said city for the purposes of a public
12 park, under the provisions of chapter one hundred
13 and eighty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and
14 seventy-five, and otherwise; and the department of
15 public works shall have charge of any land and flats
16 conveyed to the commonwealth hereunder.
