## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

---

An Act relative to the Incurring of Liabilities and Indebtedness by Certain Cities and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 All provisions of special acts effective prior to  
2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, in  
3 so far as they authorize the incurring of liabilities by  
4 boards or officials of a city except Boston or of a town  
5 without an appropriation, and all provisions of such  
6 special acts relating to the incurring of indebtedness  
7 by a city except Boston or by a town in so far as they  
8 are inconsistent with provisions of general law, are  
9 hereby repealed; but nothing herein shall be construed  
10 as affecting the validity of any act done in conformity  
11 with any special act enacted prior to the effective date  
12 of this act or any bond or note issued in accordance  
13 with any special act enacted as aforesaid.
