## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

Resolve providing for an Investigation by a Special Commission relative to the dredging of Certain Channels in Dorchester Bay.

1    *Resolved*, That the special commission established  
2 by chapter thirty-nine of the resolves of the current  
3 year, as part of its comprehensive investigation and  
4 report upon conditions in that part of Dorchester bay  
5 within the location of the Old Colony boulevard, is  
6 hereby directed to include the subject-matter of house  
7 document eleven hundred and six of the current year,  
8 in order that such dredging, if any, as said special  
9 commission recommends shall be of such character  
10 and in such location and shall be carried on in such  
11 manner as shall be consistent with the other recom-  
12 mendations of said special commission. Said special  
13 commission shall also consider the cost of such dredg-  
14 ing, if any, as it recommends, and from what source  
15 payment should be made; and in this connection  
16 whether, and if so to what extent, the construction of  
17 the Old Colony boulevard has contributed to the  
18 shoaling of the channel proposed to be dredged.
