In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to the Elimination of the Crossing at Grade at Governor Square in the City of Boston by Street Railway Cars using the Boylston Street Subway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter three hundred and forty-one of the acts  
2 of nineteen hundred and twenty-five is hereby  
3 amended by striking out section two and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following:—

5 *Section 2.* The transit department of the city of  
6 Boston may make such alterations in and extensions  
7 to the Boylston street subway as it may deem neces-  
8 sary for the purpose of eliminating the crossing at  
9 grade of Governor square by cars using said subway,  
10 for the improvement of street car service on Com-  
11 monwealth avenue and Beacon street, for the purpose  
12 of providing means for a convenient interchange of  
13 passengers between cars or trains operated in said  
14 subway and those operated on surface lines connect-  
15 ing therewith and for improving the transportation  
16 facilities furnished in said subway, and to that end
