## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

---

Resolve authorizing the Department of Public Works to lease to the City of Boston for Airport Purposes Certain Land of the Commonwealth in that Part of Said City known as East Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works,  
2 subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as  
3 the governor and council may approve, is hereby  
4 authorized to lease to the city of Boston for airport  
5 purposes for a term not exceeding twenty years land  
6 of the commonwealth in the control of said depart-  
7 ment in that part of said city called East Boston;  
8 provided, that said lease shall reserve to the com-  
9 monwealth such use of said land for military pur-  
10 poses as it may require. Said department is hereby  
11 authorized to include in said lease a provision bind-  
12 ing the commonwealth, at the end of the term  
13 thereof, to reimburse said city for expenditures  
14 made by it for filling and grading said land and also  
15 to pay such sum as shall represent the fair value, if  
16 any, to the commonwealth, for the then intended  
17 use of such runways, buildings and other structures  
18 as shall have been built on said land by and at the  
19 expense of said city.
