To accompany the petition of Edward J. Sullivan, formerly county paymaster of Suffolk County, that his retirement allowance be increased. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act providing for an Increase in the Retirement Allowance of Edward J. Sullivan, Formerly County Paymaster of Suffolk County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The retirement allowance of Ed-
2 ward J. Sullivan, for many years employed in the
3 office of the city treasurer of the city of Boston,
4 who was retired as county paymaster of Suffolk
5 County on March first, nineteen hundred and
6 twenty-three, shall, on and after the effective date
7 of this act, be at the rate of fifteen hundred dollars
8 per annum.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the mayor and city council of the
3 city of Boston, subject to the provisions of its
4 charter; provided, that such acceptance shall occur
5 during the current year.
