An Act establishing the Maximum Fees of Persons Authorized to take Bail in Certain Criminal Cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-four of chapter two hundred and
2 sixty-two of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by striking out, in the third line, the word "two"
4 and inserting in place thereof the word:—three,—
5 so as to read as follows:—*Section 24.* The maxi-
6 mum fee to be charged by any person authorized
7 to take bail in the case of a person arrested for
8 any misdemeanor shall be three dollars.
