An Act relative to Facsimile Signatures of Registers of Deeds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter thirty-six of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section nineteen and in-  
3 serting in place thereof the following:

4 *Section 19.* A facsimile of the signature of any  
5 register imprinted by him or by an assistant regis-  
6 ter or by such office assistant as the register in  
7 writing may designate, upon any original instru-  
8 ment or upon any paper or plan which he is re-  
9 quired by law to certify as a true copy, shall have  
10 the same validity as his written signature.
