## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act relative to the Civil Service Eligibility of Thomas H. Ryan of Fall River for Appointment to the Police Force of Said City.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 So much of any rule or regulation adopted  
2 under chapter thirty-one of the General Laws  
3 governing the eligibility of candidates for ap-  
4 pointment to the police force of a city or town  
5 as would disqualify Thomas H. Ryan of Fall  
6 River because of the loss of a portion of his  
7 finger while in the overseas military service of  
8 the United States in the world war shall not be  
9 applicable to the said Ryan.
