

To accompany the petition of C. Wesley Hale for legislation relative to the annual licensing of dentists and to the performance of certain other duties imposed upon registered dentists. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act relative to the Annual Licensing of Dentists and to the Performance of Certain Other Duties imposed upon Registered Dentists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-four of chapter one hundred and
2 twelve of the General Laws, as amended by chap-
3 ter one hundred and forty-seven of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, is hereby
5 further amended by striking out the third sen-
6 tence, so as to read as follows:— *Section 44.*
7 Every registered dentist when he begins practice,
8 either by himself or associated with or in the
9 employ of another, shall forthwith notify the
10 board of his office address or addresses, and every
11 registered dentist practicing as aforesaid shall
12 annually, before April first, pay to the board a
13 license fee of two dollars. Every registered den-
14 tist shall also promptly notify the board of any
15 change in his office address or addresses and shall

16 furnish such other information as the board may
17 require. The board shall publish annually com-
18 plete lists of the names and office addresses of all
19 dentists registered and practicing in the common-
20 wealth, arranged alphabetically by name and
21 also by the towns where their offices are situated.
22 Every registered dentist shall exhibit his full
23 name in plain readable letters in each office or
24 room where his business is transacted.
