## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act relative to the Membership of the Board of  
Public Welfare of the City of Haverhill.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter five hundred and seventy-  
2 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and eight is  
3 hereby amended by striking out section thirty-  
4 nine and inserting in place thereof the following:

5 *Section 39.* The mayor shall be, ex officio,  
6 chairman and a member of the board of public  
7 welfare, and the alderman having supervision of  
8 the department of health and charities shall also  
9 be, ex officio, a member of such board.

1 SECTION 2. So much of section nineteen of  
2 chapter sixty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred  
3 and sixty-nine as provides that the president of  
4 the common council and the city marshal shall  
5 be, ex officio, members of the board of overseers  
6 of the poor is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance, during the current year, by vote of  
3 the municipal council of the city of Haverhill,  
4 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not  
5 otherwise.
