The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act authorizing the Construction of a Parkway or Boulevard from a Point near the Junction of Newton Street with Hammond Street in the Town of Brookline to Beacon Street in the City of Newton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district com-
2 mission is hereby authorized to lay out and con-
3 struct, in accordance with the provisions of
4 chapter ninety-two of the General Laws relative
5 to the laying out and construction of parkways
6 and boulevards, a parkway or boulevard from a
7 point at or near the junction of Newton street
8 with Hammond street, in the town of Brookline,
9 to Beacon street, in the city of Newton, at or near
10 Hobart road, following substantially the course
11 described as "Route 1" in the special report of
12 said commission filed with the general court
13 December first, nineteen hundred and twenty-
14 eight, printed as current house document number
15 one hundred and thirty-four.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of acquiring the
2 land required for said parkway or boulevard
3 not now owned by the commonwealth and for
4 preliminary survey and the clearing of the right
5 of way, the commission may expend such sum,
6 not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars as may
7 hereafter be appropriated.

8 One half of such expenditure shall be paid by
9 the cities and towns of the metropolitan parks
10 district as a part of the cost of maintenance of
11 boulevards under section fifty-six of said chapter
12 ninety-two. The remaining one half shall be paid
13 from the highway fund of nineteen hundred and
14 twenty-nine.

1 SECTION 3. The commission may also expend
2 a sum, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, the
3 expenditure of which was authorized by chapter
4 two hundred and thirty-one of the acts of nine-
5 teen hundred and twenty-seven, and said sum
6 shall continue to be available for expenditure by
7 said commission for the purpose of said chapter.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
