To accompany the petition of Joseph J. Mulhern that the city of Boston be authorized to pay an annuity to the widow of John F. Montague, a former member of the police department of said city. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to pay an Annuity to the Widow of John F. Montague.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting
2 the public good, the city of Boston may pay to
3 Agnes T. Montague, widow of John F. Montague,
4 a former sergeant of its police department who
5 died on May twenty-fourth in the current year
6 from injuries received on the preceding day in
7 the course of a physical examination for pro-
8 motion in said department, an annuity equal to
9 two thirds of the annual rate of compensation
10 received by said John F. Montague at the date
11 of his death. Said annuity shall be payable in
12 equal monthly instalments and shall continue so
13 long as said Agnes T. Montague remains un-
14 married.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its acceptance during the current year by vote
3 of the city council of said city, subject to the
4 provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
