## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act providing for Local Option relative to the Opening of Bootblack Establishments on the Lord's Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section six of chapter one hundred and thirty-  
2 six of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
3 by chapter one hundred and eighteen of the acts  
4 of nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, is hereby  
5 further amended by inserting after the word  
6 "forenoon" in the sixty-third line the words:—  
7 , unless prohibited in a city by vote of the city  
8 council, subject to the provisions of its charter,  
9 or in a town by a by-law of said town, — so that  
10 the clause now contained in the sixty-second and  
11 sixty-third lines of said section will read as  
12 follows:— the carrying on of the business of  
13 bootblack before eleven o'clock in the forenoon,  
14 unless prohibited in a city by vote of the city  
15 council, subject to the provisions of its charter,  
16 or in a town by a by-law of said town; .
