

SENATE No. 251

To accompany the petition of Joseph J. Mulhern that the city of Boston be authorized to pay an annuity to the widow and children of John F. Montague, a former member of the police department of said city. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to pay an Annuity to the Widow and Children of John F. Montague.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the
2 public good, the city of Boston may pay to
3 Agnes T. Montague, widow of the late John F.
4 Montague, a former member of its police de-
5 partment who died on May twenty-fourth,
6 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, from injuries
7 sustained on the preceding day in the course of
8 a physical examination prescribed for promotion
9 in said department, an annuity of one thousand
10 dollars a year, so long as she remains unmarried,
11 increased by two hundred dollars a year for each
12 child of said Montague during such time as
13 each such child is under the age of eighteen; or,

14 if said widow dies, such an annuity as would
15 have been payable to her had she lived, to or
16 for the benefit of each such child, in equal shares,
17 during the time aforesaid; or, if said widow
18 remarries, in lieu of the aforesaid annuity to her,
19 an annuity of two hundred and sixty dollars to
20 or for the benefit of each such child during the
21 time aforesaid.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its acceptance, during the current year, by vote
3 of the city council of said city, subject to the
4 provisions of its charter.
