An Act dispensing with Physical Strength Tests in Examinations for Promotion in the Classified Civil Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter thirty-one of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section ten the following
- 3 new section:—
- 4 *Section 10A.* No examination for promotion to
- 5 any office or position in the classified service shall
- 6 include any test of physical strength.
