## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act limiting the Period during which Interest shall be credited to the Accounts of Members of the Teachers' Retirement Association who have left the Service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section eleven of chapter thirty-two of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws, as amended by section one of chapter  
3 three hundred and eighty-one of the acts of nineteen  
4 hundred and twenty-three and chapter two hundred  
5 and twelve of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
6 twenty-six, is hereby further amended by adding at  
7 the end thereof the following new paragraph:—(6)  
8 Interest shall not be credited to any account in the  
9 annuity fund standing in the name of any person  
10 who is entitled to withdraw such account under  
11 paragraph (1) of this section, after the third annual  
12 compounding date following the time when he be-  
13 came so entitled.
